Main responsibilities:

General tasks and responsibilities	 Yard Duties General housekeeping - keeping the yard clean, tidy and hazard free at all times. Maintaining the landscaping, including hedging, strimming, gardening and weeding. Use of forklift. Loading and unloading timber. Sorting firewood - splitting with a chainsaw and Stacking. Transporting materials to and from sites where our frames are being erected. Emptying bins and dealing with waste and recycling, including sawdust.
	 Ensuring a high level of care is taken when in and around the yard. A variety of maintenance and decorating jobs around the yard and workshops.
